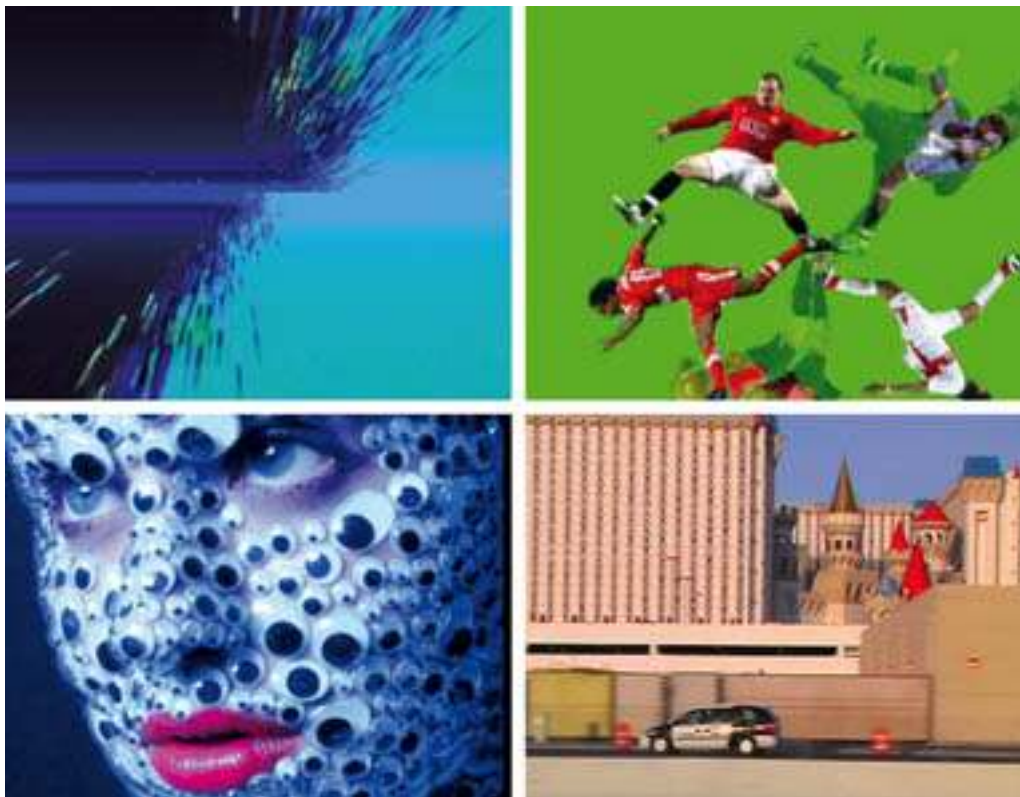

Globalscreen is a flexible media-art platform for artists and arts institutions. It stands for collaboration worldwide amongst video and media artists engaged in finding new, contemporary avenues in art and communication. These are experiments by artists from different countries turning to contemporary subjects, to political, aesthetic and philosophical contemplations and which, expressed in diverse projects, make a mark both in museum contexts and in public spaces.

Exhibitions and projects are elaborated in collaboration with the pertinent institutions and artists. The participating artists include the younger and the professionally established.

Between 2003 and 2009 Globalscreen have been presented at numerous international museums, galleries and art festivals, for example: Museum Kunst Palast Duesseldorf, D; National Museum Wroclaw/ WRO; Luigi Pecci Museum Florence-Prato/ Videominuto Festival and *Goethe Institute Dakar, Senegal*

It is an artistic examination of questions of perception and of the Zeitgeist in an era of inundation by pictures and by simulations of reality.

These increasingly influence human society, the sciences and the world economy. Perceptions are shifting, in all spheres of life. Simulations, the new DVD compilation (2009/10) presents videos by twenty-five international media artists: The genres extend from experiment to the interactive and animation and to work in documentary mode.

They make up the basis of presentations inland and abroad, to appear simultaneously as far possible. In line with the overall globalscreen concept, artists and curators taking part are augmenting the DVD collection with their own screenings, installations, performances, talks, workshops...
